This is an immersive program. Students should not take other classes outside of the Residency Program nor should they hold a job during the program. We recommend that they do not return to Oxford or home over weekends or during evenings, but stay in Over-the-Rhine as much as possible. This allows participants to bond with the community and it builds a stronger cohort.
